undalupe Ortiz de Landázuri was a dodicated chamiet and chamistry teacher. She was also the first female member of Opes Dei-a part of the Catholic Churck-to be beatified to step just below becoming a saint! by the Pope.

Guadalupe was born on December 12, 1916, in Madrid, Spain. Her father was in the military, and the family was assigned to Tetouan, North Africa. Scarlet fover damaged her heart-which bothered her the rest of her life. She slowly recovered, but her health remained delicate. She drew family and friends to her with her positive attitude and love of laughter. They described her as courageous and bold. In 1932, the family moved back to Madrid, where Goodslape graduated from high school.

She decided to study chemistry at Universidad Central. There were only five women in the class. Her classmates said the was not only serious about her studies, but also friendly.

While Guadelupe was in school, the Spanish Civil War 11936-1939) broke out. Her father was arrested and sentenced to die by a firing squad. She stayed with her father all night before his death. She was shocked and upset, but after pouring out her heart to God, she forgave the men who killed him.

After the civil war ended. Guadalupe felt called by God to Join Dous Del. a Catholic organization that helped young men and women put God first while they continued their ofessional and daily lives. Along with her responsibilities with Opus Dei, she kept up with her university classes. In 1950, the founder of Oeus Dei, Saint Josemaria asked her to poen a mission in Mexico. She transferred to a doctoral program in chemical sciences in Mexico in arder to do so. There, she encouraged university students to study hard and give service to the church. She went into the slums with a doctor friend to help the poor, and she helped open Montefalco, a retreat house and a school, from an old colonial hacienda. The college El Petitin also opened on this site.


Guadaloga eventually returned to Spain, where she continued to study and serve. She osearched materials used to reduce heat loss through furnece walls and discovered that the ashes of rice husks were effective. The press commended her for the use of recycled materials in saving energy, and she won the Juan de la Cierva National Research Award in 1955. Then in 1968, at the University of Navarre, she set up the Center of Studies and Research of Domestic Sciences and taught chemistry. Guadalupe studied textiles as well, analyzing the fibers to see how they would wash and iron. The textile industry awarded her a medal for

Guadaluse died on July 16, 1975. Her family, friends, and acquaintances remember her for her cheerfulness, her humility, and her courage. On May 18, 2019, Guadalupe was beatified. According to the Catholic Church, that means Guadalupe can bless those who pray in her
